

TOWN OF BINGHAMTON
CANNABIS DISTRIBUTION AND CONSUMPTION SITES LOCAL LAW #4 of 2022

Under the authority of the Cannabis Control Board (CCB), the Town of Binghamton creates the following Local Law #4 of 2022 to manage the operation of any cannabis distribution sites, and any cannabis consumption sites.

Cannabis Distribution Sites:

1. Hours of operation will be no greater than 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 a.m. Sunday through Saturday
2. The site must be at least 100 yards from any school, historical site, medical facility and any house of worship.
3. Before installing any permanent signs, the store owner must contact the code enforcement department to obtain approval.
4. The facility must be located in an existing areas zoned Commercial.
5. Appropriate permits must be obtained.
6. Required number of parking spaces is 1 for every 100 square feet of retail space.

Cannabis Consumption Sites:

1. Hours of operation will be no greater than 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m., Sunday through Saturday
2. The site must be at least 500 yards from any school, historical site medical facility and any house of worship.
3. Product odor must be undetectable within 200 yards.
4. Noise levels must not exceed the permitted volume allowed by the Town Code.
5. Before installing any permanent signs, the store owner must contact the code enforcement department to obtain approval.
6. The facility must be located in an existing area zoned Commercial.
7. Appropriate permits be obtained.
8. Required number of parking spaces is 1 for every 100 square feet of retail space.
