## TOWN OF BINGHAMTON CANNABIS DISTRIBUTION AND CONSUMPTION SITES LOCAL LAW #4 of 2022

Under the authority of the Cannabis Control Board (CCB), the Town of Binghamton creates the following Local Law #4 of 2022 to manage the operation of any cannabis distribution sites, and any cannabis consumption sites.

Cannabis Distribution Sites:

- 1. Hours of operation will be no greater than 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 a.m. Sunday through Saturday
- 2. The site must be at least 100 yards from any school, historical site, medical facility and any house of worship.
- 3. Before installing any permanent signs, the store owner must contact the code enforcement department to obtain approval.
- 4. The facility must be located in an existing areas zoned Commercial.
- 5. Appropriate permits must be obtained.
- 6. Required number of parking spaces is 1 for every 100 square feet of retail space.

Cannabis Consumption Sites:

- 1. Hours of operation will be no greater than 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m., Sunday through Saturday
- 2. The site must be at least 500 yards from any school, historical site medical facility and any house of worship.
- 3. Product odor must be undetectable within 200 yards.
- 4. Noise levels must not exceed the permitted volume allowed by the Town Code.
- 5. Before installing any permanent signs, the store owner must contact the code enforcement department to obtain approval.
- 6. The facility must be located in an existing area zoned Commercial.
- 7. Appropriate permits be obtained.
- 8. Required number of parking spaces is 1 for every 100 square feet of retail space.
